The Cabriolet has sufficient storage and accommodation for longer trips and ocean crossings too.

The Scape 39' open deck is designed and developed to be the ultimate open deck catamaran for both you and your guests. The Scape 39' is incredibly easy to handle and can be sailed single handed. This fast energy efficient catamaran is low maintenance and ready to sail. There are various layout options available to suit your individual needs. These include fridges, seating arrangements and dagger boards and an option of a spray dodger. The Scape 39' is great for coastal and blue water sailing. As well as being the ultimate open deck vessel it is ideal for day charters. The Scape 39' is built with top quality products, using the latest technology and highest quality fittings. The Scape 39' can carry up to 40 passengers and sleeps 6.

Layout & Accommodations

There are good-sized double platform berths all the way aft in each hull plus a head for each hull up forward. In the middle of the port hull there is a small stand-up nav station; the starboard hull has a small galley with a fixed range and sink. Both hulls also have narrow single berths in the bows forward of collision bulkheads which can only be accessed through bow hatches. Standing headroom in the hulls is a whisper under 6 feet, and plenty of storage under berths as well as large open shelves behind the dagger board cases.

The starboard hull has a small galley with a 2-burner propane stove, stainless steel sink and cooler/ fridge
