Construction

Materials used: infusion of polyester resin and high quality anti-osmosis resin on a balsa wood frame and fibre glass skin. Hull bottom and keel in infused monolithic laminate.

Structural partitions (sandwich balsa) par infusion.

Bilge painted light grey.

Hull finished with white gel coat.

Bridge in white gel coat with non-slip diamond plate.

Large main salon with panoramic view - standing headroom approx: 6' 9"

Steel pillar with fabric cover

Varnished coffee table that can be swapped with the large cockpit table

Flybridge

Engine panel on port side

All lines led to forward section of flybridge around 3 winches.

3 Line storage boxes.

Glass holder + storage tray on the port side

Seat on starboard side.

Sun bathing area to rear of flybridge

Helmsman base cushion

2 flush deck hatches that can be used as scoops near cockpit

1 mainsail winch to rear of the flybridge.
