- OWNER'S - 2 heads on port, owner-dedicated starboard hull with vast forward head and shower
- CHARTER - 4 cabins 4 heads

Mattress and upholstery upholstery

- Cabins mattresses: marine mattresses made of multi layer alveolar foam with several densities. Mattresses designed to improve comfort for a deeper sleep (thickness: 120mm/5")
- Mattresses treatment: anti microbial, anti bacterial, non allergenic, anti dust mite
- Standard upholstery as indicated on Lagoon sample book
- Synthetic fabrics adapted to marine environment:
 - washable (40°C)
 - U.V. resistant

Galley in main salon to starboard with direct access to cockpit through sliding window

Deck & Equipment

AFT COCKPIT

- Large cockpit usable as deck salon, protected by fixed composite bimini with recessed cockpit lighting
- U-shape foredeck seating area with technical generator locker on the front
- Removable wood varnished cockpit table accommodates 8 / 10 people, with protective cover
- 2 storage lockers in stern crossbeam
- Large storage locker with possibility to install extra (fridge, icemaker, etc...)
- Synthetic resin countertop
- Sliding window between cockpit and galley
- Direct access from cockpit to helm station on starboard side
- Lazy boy on starboard side with storage locker
- Bin with upper access and front door
- Storage locker with top access (70 liters / 18 gallon US) with drainage
- Aeration hatch - Opening roof on the fly for cockpit aeration
- Storage for 2 gas tanks on starboard side of

FORWARD DECK

- Storage locker on aft cockpit portside
- Big storage locker
- Access to the windlass and chain locker by a vertical pannel
- Deck light on mast
- Locker on starboard side (genset as an option)
- Sun pad
- Settee

BOW COMPARTMENTS

- Access from deck through locked hatch (starboard sides and on aft beam)
- Adhesive Lagoon logos on roof sides

FLYBRIDGE

- Twin deck access stairways from deck
- Large bench seat for 6 people

- Ergonomically-designed helm station with leathered wheel with brake, engine throttles, engine panels, hourmeters, compass, large instrument console for electronic displays, cup holders, rope storage
- Protection cover for helm position
- Space storage around lateral staircases of the flybridge
- Sun pad place in front of the helm station

TRANSOMS

- 2 opening access hatches to engine compartments
- the cockpit
- Built-in storage area for cockpit table in bimini ceiling
 - Polyester non streaming toe rail on the cockpit sides

Electrical, Power & Plumbing

PLUMBING

- 2 water tanks (2x 175l / 46 US gallons each = total 350l /92 US gallons)
- Freshwater system with 1 principal water group in portside hull
- Filter
- 60l /16 US gallons water heater with 220V heating element and engine heat exchanger
- 2 fuel aluminium tanks (2x 500l / 132 US gallons), fuel filters
- Shower drain pumps by press button
- Bilge pump: 1 manual bilge pump in each hull with cockpit pump ; 1 automatic immersed bilge pump by hull ; 1 manual release non-immersed bilge pump by hull
- 1 holding tank (80l / 21 US gallons) in stern portside in standard

ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

- Main 12V electrical panel starboard side of salon next to companionway with wood protection
- LED lights
- Ammeter, voltmeter, circuit breakers, back lighting, water gauge, 12V outlet, fuel gauge
- 2 engine start batteries: 12 v- 110 Amp
- 3 house batteries: 12 v-140 Amp

- 1 dacron full roach full batten mainsail, Lagoon logo

- Aluminium mast with mainsail track and ball-bearing

- 1 forestay with furler for genoa
- 2 mainsail lazy-jacks for battened main sail

- 1 double-purchase spectra mainsail halyard

- 1 mainsail sheet pre-stretched
- 2 genoa sheets pre-stretched
- 3 mainsail reefing lines pre-stretched
- 1 genoa furling line pre-stretched
- 2 mainsail traveller car control lines pre-stretched

HARDWARE

- 8 mooring cleats
- 1 winch size 60 on starboard side of helm for mainsail halyard and reefing lines and genoa
- 1 winch, size 50, on port side for genoa halyard, spi (option), topping lift
- 1 winch, size 60, for genoa on port side
- 1 winch, size 50, for main sheet, traveller and furler
- Vertical axe windlass 12V 1700W in anchor locker, with 12 mm gypsy
- Trampoline with knot-less nylon netting
- Extern stern pulpits
- Inboard stern pulpits including on portside flagpole fittings and buoy support
- Composite forward longitudinal beam with recessed chain run and mooring cleat
- Aluminium crossbeam with furler genoa chain plate, anchor roller and navigation lights
- Mainsheet traveller track and ball-bearing car
